Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Who should I contact if I have questions?

For all inquiries regarding the Orhun Exchange Program at Bursa Uludağ University (BUU), please contact the Orhun Office via orhun@uludag.edu.tr.

To ensure a prompt response, please include your:

- Full name
- Home university
- Semester (Fall/Spring)

Where can I find official information?

The most up-to-date information is available on the official [BUU Orhun website](#), in the Student Guide, and via official email announcements from the BUU Orhun Office.

Is accommodation guaranteed?

No.

Accommodation is provided subject to availability and institutional capacity. The accommodation status is indicated in the official invitation letter sent to the Orhun Coordinator at your home university. Students are advised to confirm this information with their home university coordinator before traveling.

Do I need to complete the Learning Agreement before arrival?

Yes.

The Learning Agreement should first be prepared and approved by your home university before your arrival. It will be finalized after consultation with the Student Affairs Office at BUU.

When should I arrive at Bursa Uludağ University?

Students should plan their arrival according to the official registration and course enrollment dates specified in the Academic Calendar.

For the fall term of the 2026-2027 academic year, students are expected to arrive at BUU on **28.09.2026**.

For the spring term of the 2026-2027 academic year, students are expected to arrive at BUU on **22.02.2027**.

What documents must I prepare before arriving?

- Learning Agreement
- [Student Obligation Agreement](#)
- [Student Declaration](#)
- Orhun Student Form
- Passport
- Visa (if applicable)
- Other legal documents required for entry into Türkiye

What is the Orhun Student Form?

The Orhun Student Form collects information required by the relevant Turkish authorities, including personal details and passport information. It must be completed and submitted within the requested deadline via email. The forms are shared before the semester via email.

Do I need a visa or a residence permit?

Students are responsible for complying with all Turkish regulations, including visa, residence permit, and health insurance requirements where applicable.

For residence permit procedures, please visit the official website of the [Directorate General of Migration Management](#).

When should I register after arrival?

As the first step, you should visit the Orhun Office at the BUU Rectorate Building. After the required documents are verified, you will continue the registration process with your faculty's Student Affairs Office.

How do I register for courses?

Course registration is completed at the Student Affairs Office of your host faculty.

Your selected courses must:

- correspond to your academic program,
- be approved by your Faculty Coordinator,
- be reflected in your Learning Agreement.

Can I choose any course I wish?

No.

Course enrolment is subject to academic and administrative approval. Students are expected to select courses that are compatible with their academic program, year of study, and the curriculum of their home institution. Course availability and the approval of the relevant Faculty Coordinator are also required.

Can I change the courses on the Learning Agreement approved by my Home University?

Yes.

If necessary, the Learning Agreement may be revised after arrival based on course availability at BUU and compatibility with your home university's curriculum.

Where Do I Register for Accommodation?

Accommodation arrangements are coordinated through the accommodation unit. Registration procedures will be shared with eligible students.

Can Orhun Exchange students benefit from meal services?

Yes.

Orhun Exchange students are eligible to use the university refectory for lunch throughout their exchange period. Students staying in the guesthouse may also receive breakfast, subject to the guesthouse's arrangements.

How do I reach Bursa Uludağ University from the Bursa Bus Terminal?

- Bus (Lines 93 or H1), or
- Tram (T2) followed by the Bursa Metro to “Üniversite” Station.

Where can I find the Academic Calendar?

The official Academic Calendar is published on the [BUU website](#) and includes semester dates, examination periods, and academic deadlines.

Who is my Faculty Coordinator?

How can I find the correct faculty or department?

Students should consult the official list of [BUU faculties and departments](#) (under “Akademik”) before preparing Learning Agreements. For each student, the faculty and department information is indicated in the official invitation letter sent to the Orhun Coordinator at your home university.

How do I obtain my Certificate of Attendance at the end of the exchange?

The Certificate of Attendance is sent via email at the end of the semester.
