ISKUR Youth Program Support for 1,750 Students at BUU

1,750 students studying at BUU have gained the opportunity to acquire work experience and generate income within the scope of the ISKUR Youth Program. Thanks to the program, students will have the chance to work while continuing their education. While the practice aims to develop the professional skills of young people and ensure they make a stronger start in post-graduation employment, it also contributes to the university's policies supporting sustainable education and youth employment.



Financial Support for Students through HGS Park at BUU

The HGS Park system implemented at BUU aims to contribute to sustainable campus management while enhancing campus traffic order and safety. The HGS park system is intended to make parking usage more organized. The revenues to be generated are planned to be transferred to students as scholarships; this practice supports the access of economically disadvantaged youth to educational opportunities, thereby contributing to equal opportunity.



BUU Student Clothing House

The Student Clothing House, operating within BUU, is a social support initiative that provides free services to students in need, primarily those who are relatives of martyrs and veterans, earthquake survivors, and students receiving non-refundable scholarships from KYK. Aiming to meet the basic clothing needs of students, this service contributes to the ability of students facing economic difficulties to continue their education in a more secure and comfortable manner. With its inclusive approach supporting equal opportunity in education, the Student Clothing House stands out as one of Bursa Uludag University's sustainability-oriented practices that strengthen social solidarity.

BUU Faculty of Theology Merit Scholarship

Bursa Uludağ University Faculty of Theology offers monthly merit scholarship opportunities to students who choose the faculty based on their YKS (Higher Education Institutions Exam) placement success rankings for the 2024-2025 academic year. Within the scope of the program, students ranked in the top 100 will receive 15,000 TL, those ranked between 101-500 will receive 10,000 TL, and students between 501-1,000 will receive 7,500 TL as a monthly scholarship. Additionally, various other scholarship supports amounting to 5,000 TL, 4,000 TL, 3,000 TL, and 2,000 TL will be provided based on success rankings. For students who are certified hafız (memorizers of the Quran) and rank in the top 25,000 in the Theology M.T.O. (Vocational Technical Secondary Education) program, there is a monthly scholarship opportunity of 1,500 TL. This initiative aims to support successful students and strengthen the qualified educational environment.
