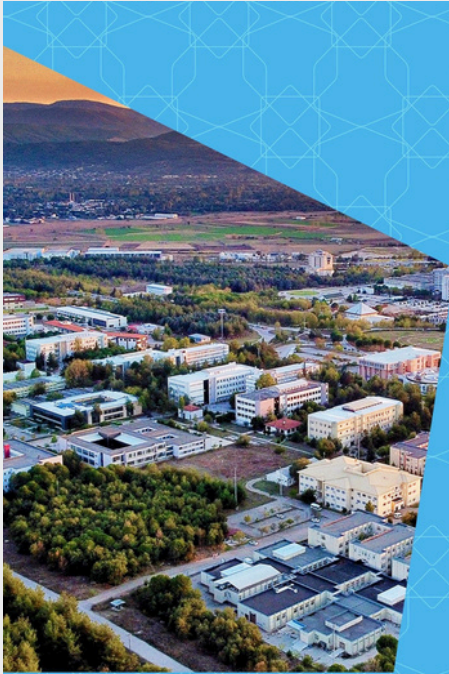

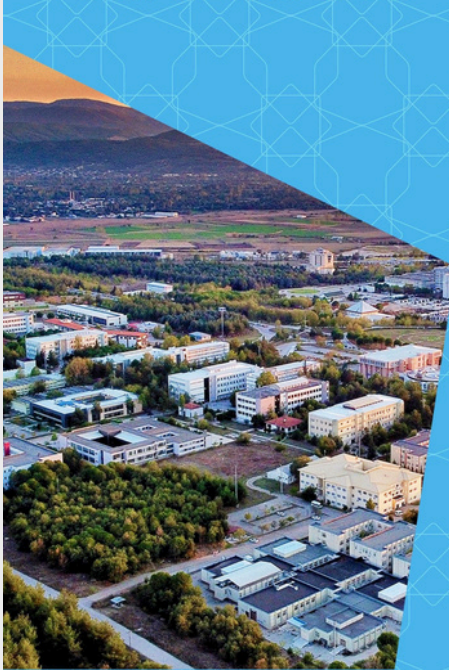
Skilled Training Across Bursa

Advancing Internationalisation Through Academic Collaboration

BUU is committed to becoming an active player in global education and research. As a designated research university, internationalisation is not viewed as a standalone initiative, but as a core component of its academic vision.

BUU's approach to internationalization goes beyond mobility programs. It encompasses long-term academic partnerships, joint research projects, and the strengthening of global academic collaboration, through actively signed Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with the higher education institutions around the world.

BUU's internationalization strategies include the development of bilateral agreements, increased participation in academic networks, and the implementation of structured exchange programs such as Erasmus+, Secondos, and the Orhun Exchange Program.

As part of its research university identity, BUU strategically encourages research collaborations and joint publications. Internationally funded projects, such as Erasmus+, are actively carried out, alongside exchange and cooperation activities with eligible countries through programs like Erasmus and Orhun. Other academic and scientific activities in shared areas of interest are also supported.

Driving Academic Mobility and Partnership

At BUU, the Erasmus+ Office coordinates student and staff mobility activities under the Higher Education sector of the Erasmus+ Programme.

The office actively engage in both nationally and centrally managed projects that support international academic exchange and collaboration. Through KA131 projects, students and staff can benefit from mobility opportunities within EU member states and partner countries. This includes study abroad, internships, and staff training or teaching assignments. The KA171 projects expand mobility beyond Europe, building academic partnerships with institutions in various regions around the world. BUU also takes part in centralized Erasmus+ projects such as Jean Monnet and Erasmus Mundus, enhancing its role in European academic networks and joint graduate programs.

With this role, the Erasmus+ Office acts as a catalyst for BUU's internationalisation, by facilitating mobility, fostering academic partnerships, and accelerating the university's integration into global education networks.

Uniting the Turkic Academic Space

The Orhun Exchange Program is a student and academic staff mobility initiative among universities that are members of the Turkic Universities Union (TÜRKÜNİB) under the Organisation of Turkic States. The program allows undergraduate, master's, and doctoral students to participate in one-semester exchanges at TÜRKÜNİB member institutions.

BUU joined the Orhun Exchange Program in 2021, and it has been actively implemented since the 2022–2023 academic year. Each year, BUÜ welcomes 20 students and academic staff from member universities. BUU receives an impressive number of applications, reflecting its growing reputation, strong regional appeal, and its growing visibility as a key academic destination in the Turkic world.

The university's active role in this regional initiative reflects its broad internationalization vision—demonstrating a strong commitment to inclusive and diverse cooperation, as well as its active presence in various international platforms and networks.

Tailoring Exchange with Innsbruck

The Secondos Exchange Program is a unique mobility initiative established through a special bilateral agreement between BUU and the University of Innsbruck (Austria).

It is tailored specifically for BUU and funded by the University of Innsbruck. Each semester, the program supports the exchange of two PhD students and one master's student.

Incoming undergraduate and graduate students, as well as outgoing graduate students, benefit from mobility opportunities under this scheme.

IAESTE Internship Programme

Providing Internships for BUU's Technical Talents

The IAESTE (International Association for the Exchange of Students for Technical Experience) Internship Exchange Program offers BUU students the opportunity to gain professional experience abroad.

Operating in over 80 countries, IAESTE provides paid, course-related internships in technical fields such as engineering, natural sciences, and applied arts. The program fosters cultural exchange and supports students in building international networks while advancing their professional skills.

BUÜ has a structured system in place to promote IAESTE announcements regularly and coordinate the application process to ensure smooth participation. Undergraduate and graduate students from BUU's Faculties of Engineering, Architecture, Veterinary Medicine, and Science & Letters actively participate in the program each year.
