


TAKE OFF




TAKE OFF 2021





Take Off 2021 received 900 startup applications from over 80 countries and 156 mentor applications from over 30 countries. It has been held as a hybrid event this year, yet most of the attendees joined the event physically between 20 and 22 September 2021 at Istanbul Atatürk Airport. 99 startups, 46 mentors, and 36 supporting institutions from 33 countries participated in the summit.

The three-day summit hosted activities on different themes to provide a chance to startups not only to be among the top three and receive awards but also to take steps to expand their business.











The theme of the first day Mentorship Day. was one-to-one Over 150 mentorship meetings were organized before the summit. During the first day, startups met with their preferred menand all startups tors, were evaluated by at least two mentors. As a result of the evaluations of mentors, the top 30 startups were selected as semi-finalists. In parallel with the mentorship meetings, "Elevator Pitch Workshop" themed training was given by Mukul Agarwal.

Day 2 Business Day

The second day of the summit started with the trainina "Corporaon te-Startup Collaborations" to both institutions and startups. Then, startups came together with 96 executives from 36 stakeholder institutions, and over 400 meetings were held, 50 of which simultaneous. 30 were semi-finalist startups made 1-minute elevator pitches at the main stage and the jury decided that the best 16 startups qualified for the finals.




Day 3 Conference Day

The third day of the summit was open to visitors and the theme was the Conference Day. Mehmet Fatih Kacır, Deputy Minister of Industry and Technology, Selçuk Bayraktar, and Technology Bavkar Leader and Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the T3 Foundation, gave their opening speeches. During the day, valuable keynote speakers talked the about technology and innovation studies carried out in Turkey and the National Technology Initiative.






Having continued as the best practice of the first Take Off since 2018, the summit hosted over 150+ mentorship meetings in 2021. In the two sessions, there were 40 simultaneous one-on-one mentor-startup meetings. Each startup met with at least two mentors, talked about their products, value propositions, and teams; took advice from their mentors, and tried to collect the highest score to qualify for the semi-finals.



Corporate Meetings



Nearly 100 executives from Turkey's leading investment funds, accelerators, incubators, and ecosystem institutions met with the entrepreneurs throughout the day and told them about the opportunities in Turkey and possible collaborations. On this day of 55 simultaneous meetings, on average a startup had 4 meetings, while some institutions had the opportunity to meet with dozens of startups.


