BURSA

Bursa, the 4th biggest city of Turkey, is located on the north-west skirts of the Mount Uludağ and the south-east of the Marmara Sea.

TRANSPORTATION

By Bus from Istanbul New Airport:

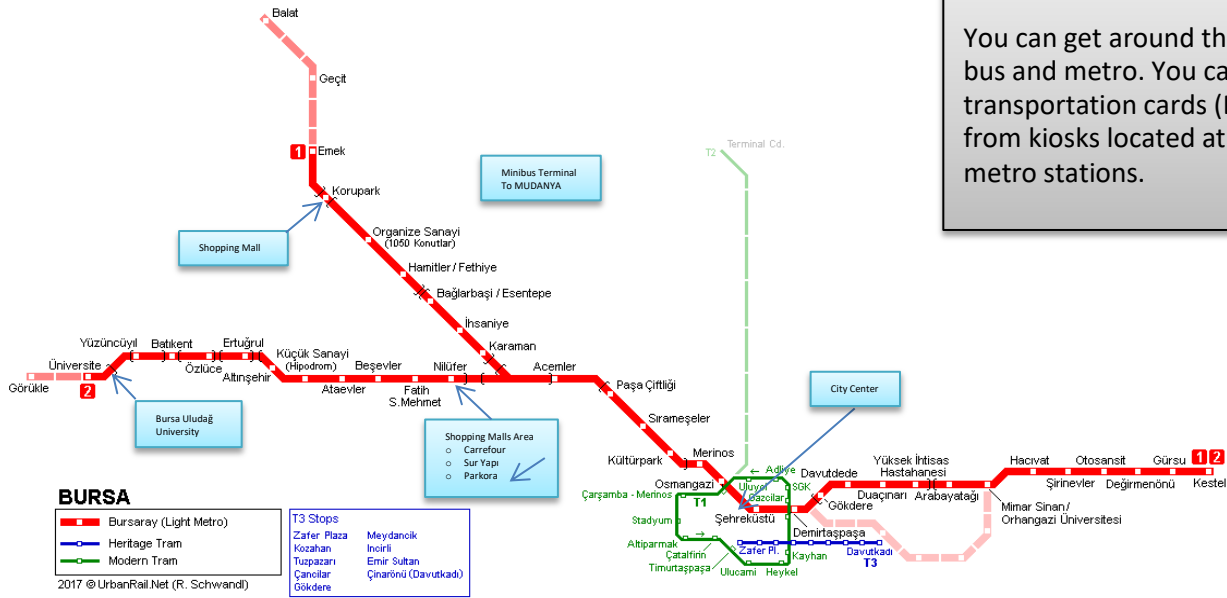
There are two bus companies to Bursa at **Istanbul New Airport** and this is the easiest way to arrive at Bursa directly. These bus companies are: Burulas and Istanbul Konfor. It takes approximately 3 hours to Bursa Bus Terminal and it costs 70 Turkish liras.

From the Bus Terminal to Campus:

Take the bus no **93** from **Bursa Bus Terminal** to Bursa Uludağ University Campus. The bus to the campus takes approximately **50 minutes**.

By Bus from Istanbul Sabiha Gokcen Airport:

1. Once you have landed on **Istanbul Sabiha Gökçen Airport**, you can take a direct bus to Bursa at the arrival exit of the airport. The bus company is Burulas and the price of the bus is 40 Turkish Liras. It takes 1,5 hours to arrive at Bursa Bus Terminal.

**How to get around in Bursa**

You can get around the city by bus and metro. You can buy transportation cards (BuKart) from kiosks located at the metro stations.

FOOD There is one dining hall for students and an other fort he staff which serve 3 different launch menus and salads around 1,5 €.

ACCOMMODATION The incoming staff can stay at Nilufer Hatun Guest House located on campus. The price for a double room is 9 € and single room is 9 €. (Please check the price with the Erasmus Office before arrival). In the rooms; there is a kitchen including kettle and mini fridge. It's not possible to cook in the rooms. There are bed linens and towels in the rooms and the rooms are being cleaned by the staff of the guest house upon request.
