



ABOUT BURSA ULUDAĞ UNIVERSITY

As an institution committed to raising contemporary, democratic, free-thinking young individuals with a strong sense of personal responsibility, guided by reason and science, who respect societal beliefs and values, embrace cultural and historical heritage, and possess an international vision, our university comprises 15 faculties, 3 schools, 15 vocational schools, 1 conservatory, 4 institutes, 25 application and research centers, 1 research center, and 5 departments affiliated with the Rectorate. The foundation of our university lies in the establishment of the Bursa Faculty of Medicine in 1970 under Istanbul University, and the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences in 1974. Officially founded as "Bursa University" through Law No. 1873, published in the Official Gazette No. 15205 on April 11, 1975, the institution was renamed "Uludağ University" on July 20, 1982, under Statutory Decree No. 41 concerning the Organization of Higher Education Institutions. Later, with the enactment of Law No. 7141, published in the Official Gazette No. 30425 on May 18, 2018, the university was renamed "BURSA ULUDAĞ UNIVERSITY."



ABOUT KARACABEY VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Karacabey is a major center for agriculture, livestock, and agro-industries in Turkey, especially in dairy technologies, animal feed, food production, and agricultural machinery. To meet the region's sectoral needs, Bursa Uludağ University established Karacabey Vocational School in 1996 and signed a cooperation protocol in 1998 to enhance applied education. With this partnership, the school was relocated near the organized industrial zone and transformed into an industry-integrated institution. Collaborating with 13 local companies, it provides students with internship, workplace training, and scholarship opportunities. Today, the school continues its educational activities with 46 staff members across six programs. With strong ties to industry, Karacabey Vocational School plays an important role in training qualified professionals who meet the workforce demands of both the region and the country.

PROGRAM INTRODUCTION

The vision of the Laboratory and Veterinary Health Program at Karacabey Vocational School is to train qualified technicians equipped with up-to-date knowledge and skills in animal health and laboratory technologies. Students receive both theoretical and practical training in areas such as dairy farming and pet animal care. The program's mission is to graduate veterinary health technicians who can work in modern livestock enterprises, farms, pharmaceutical companies, and feed factories, and who possess strong communication, practical skills, and ethical values. With a broad course structure, field experiences, internship opportunities, and technical infrastructure, students are equipped with both technical and practical education, transforming them into sought-after professionals.
