ON-LINE APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Applications for programs for which quotas have been announced in the fall semester of the 2024-2025 academic year will be made electronically via the internet within the application dates, without interruption. Before starting the "On-line Application" process, carefully read the information regarding the quotas, application conditions and evaluation criteria below.

IMPORTANT NOTICES

- 1. The interview quota will be 30 for programs with 15 or less quotas, and twice the quota for programs with more than 15 quotas.
- 2. Candidates can apply to a Thesis or a Non-Thesis program at the same time. It is not possible to apply to two thesis or two non-thesis programs at the same time.
- 3. Applications will be made "on-line". Applications by mail will not be accepted.
 - Candidates are required to submit the on-line application form to the interview jury members during the interview.
 - Candidates must bring their "transcripts" (certified photocopies) showing their undergraduate/master's grade point averages, which they declared during their application, with them during the interview an it is mandatory to keep them and submit them to the interview jury. Candidates who do not submit their transcript to the interview jury will not be interviewed. Even if they attend the interview, their applications will be deemed invalid. The transcript received from e-government is valid.
- 4. The information filled in during the online application will be considered as the candidate's declaration.
 - Candidates who are eligible for final registration must register in person with the required documents at the Directorate of the Graduate School of Health Sciences within the announced final registration period (In transactions that cannot be completed in person due to force majeure, delays will not be taken into account in documents sent by registered mail or courier).
- 5. Applications that do not comply with the prerequisites of the Department and Bursa Uludağ University Graduate Education Regulations will be rejected.
- 6. Candidates must follow their interview lists and results through the online system where they applied.
- 7. During the evaluation phase, if students have both 4-point grading system scores and universities' 100-point system scores on their transcripts, the student must <u>definitely</u> enter their 4-point system score into the system.
- 8. These grades are automatically converted by the online application system in accordance with YÖK's 4-point system conversion table.
- 9. Foreign national candidates must have their relevant documents approved by the Foreign Representatives of the Republic of Turkey in their own country and must bring copies of the approved documents translated into Turkish by a Sworn Translator to the institute.
- 10. Foreign national candidates who are entitled to final registration must first register with our Institute and obtain a student number.
- 11. A graduation grade of 2.25 is not required for candidates who have worked as managers in the public or private sector for at least 10 years. Candidates in this situation must submit documents proving that they are a manager to our Institute within the application dates.
- 12. The tuition fee for foreign candidates is 10,232.50 Turkish Liras for one semester (fall semester).

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

APPLICATION CONDITIONS AND CRITERIA AND EVALUATION / ACCEPTANCE:.

APPLICATION CONDITIONS and CRITERIA:

1. ALES result document; (ALES exam results are valid for 5 years from the date of announcement.) A minimum of 55 points is required for Master's / PhD Programs, and 80 points are required for those applying for a PhD with a bachelor's degree. The ALES score type for the Department of Coaching Education of the Faculty of Sports Sciences is EQUALLY WEIGHTED, while the ALES score type for other departments is NUMERICAL.

* ALES Certificate is not required for foreign candidates.

- 2. The Medical Specialty Examination (TUS) score is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of the examination.
- 3. Foreign Language Exam Result Certificate; (The validity period for foreign language exams held by ÖSYM is determined as the last 5 years.) *The Foreign Language requirement for the Master's Program is required in some Departments according to the decision of the Departments, and this is stated in the prerequisites. **For the PhD Program, it is required to have at least 55 points.
- ** Including foreign nationals, having received at least 55 points for PhD from YDS/YÖKDİL or International foreign language exams whose equivalence is accepted by ÖSYM. is required (For foreign candidates, it must be other than their native language).
- **4. Foreign national candidates who will apply for Thesis/Non-Thesis Master's and PhD programs** are required to have a C1 level document proving that they have passed the Turkish exam conducted **by the language centers of universities or YEE / ULUTÖMER** (those studying in Turkey are excluded).
- 5. Graduation Certificate: A certified copy of the Bachelor's Certificate for those applying for the Thesis/Non-Thesis Master's program, and a certified copy of the Master's Certificate with Thesis for those applying for the PhD program. The original or an officially approved copy of the recognition certificate received from the Council of Higher Education, along with the diploma or graduation certificates from candidates who have completed their undergraduate/master's program abroad.
- 6. Transcript: *The approved document (transcript-transcript) containing the general academic achievement GPA, which forms the basis for graduation, is valid.
 - * Graduation grade point average; at least 2.25 according to the 4-point system

according to the 100-point system, a minimum score of 59.16 is required.

*Among those who apply to the PhD program with a bachelor's degree; at least 3.00 according to the 4-point system according to the 100-point system, at least 76.66 points are required.

- 2) ALES or equivalent exam result document: TUS certificate or computer printout from Faculty of Medicine graduates who are accepted to Basic Medical Sciences PhD programs, and DUS certificate or computer printout from Dentistry graduates.
- 3) Transcript: A certified photocopy of the document showing the transcript of courses and grades and the graduation success score or a printout taken from egovernment
- 4) Computer printout of the exam result document whose equivalence is accepted by YDS / YÖKDİL or ÖSYM (for PhD programs)

- 1) Certified copy of the diploma or graduation certificate: Notarized translation of the diploma or graduation certificate received abroad and the original or officially approved copies of the recognition certificate received from the Council of Higher Education.
- 2) Transcript: The original or an officially approved copy of the document showing the transcript of courses and grades and the graduation success score; Courses and transcripts taken from foreign countries, originals or officially approved copies of notarized translations
- 3) C1 level document proving that they have passed the Turkish exam conducted by ULUTÖMER, YEE or TÖMER: (Except for those who graduated from a higher education institution in Turkey) Candidates who do not have a C1 certificate are given 1 year to obtain this document.
- 4) Computer printout of the exam result document whose equivalence is accepted by YDS / YÖKDİL or ÖSYM (for PhD programs)
- 5) Passport: Notarized copy of the passport with a student visa translated into Turkish
- 6) Residence permit: The original or officially approved copy of the residence permit obtained from the Provincial Police Department must be delivered to the Institute within one month at the latest from the final registration date.
