Cooperation Protocol

Bursa Uludağ University (BUU) signed the 'Agricultural Education Cooperation' protocol with Osmangazi Municipality on 28.07.2022 with the aim of spreading the use of local seeds throughout Bursa and reaching them to the citizens. BUÜ signed a cooperation protocol with Osmangazi Municipality in **order** to ensure that citizens who are out of agricultural activities are also involved in production. Within the framework of the signed protocol, training will be given by academicians working at BUU Faculty of Agriculture.

In the administrative building of the Center for Ecological Life, theoretical training will be given to citizens about ancestral seed breeding, production and its importance. Citizens will be able to put the theoretical knowledge they have learned into practice in the greenhouse section of the center.
