A splitboarder, rock climber, mountain runner, and waterwoman, she has been featured in the Washington Post, She Explores, Women on the Road, the Los Angeles Times, and regional publications throughout the American West.

Currently partnered with Protect Our Winters, Salomon, Suunto, Trail Butter, Anon Optics, and Athletic Brewing, her mission is to inspire individual action and collective communion through self-care and self-determination found in the outdoors.

Her goal as a mountain athlete is to find the limits of her possible, searching for high peaks and ski lines that tell the story of Mother
