1. Time Period

June 27-July 19, 2024 (3 weeks) / Orientation on June 29

- Free Airport Pick up will be arranged on June 27th (Thu) & 28th (Fri).
- Free Airport Drop off will be arranged on July 20th (Sat) & 21st (Sun) from the dormitory.
- You must arrange your own transportation from/to the airport besides the arranged pick up/drop off time.

2. Eligibility

- Students currently enrolled in a college/university.
- Korean proficiency is not required. Korean language courses will be conducted in two levels, beginner and intermediate. (Halla Buddies are going to support participants during the program).

3. VISA

- Applicants must apply for a short-term study visa (D-2-8) to their Korean Embassy or Consulate Office.
- We encourage applicants to apply for the visa as soon as they receive a letter of admission.

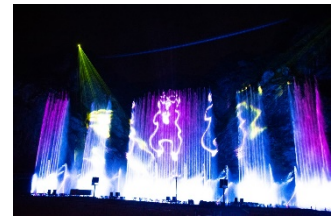


4. Fees and Scholarships

- Program Fee: FREE (including tuition, accommodation, and some meals)
- Accommodation will be provided only during the program.
- Other Costs (paid by participant):
 - Application fee: USD 100 (non-refundable)
 - Round-trip Airfare
 - Visa(D-2-8) issuance fee
 - Meals when it is not provided
 - You must provide your own international health insurance from your home country.
 - Fees for Optional activities, Travel expenses and Other living costs

- Tae Kwon Do / Korean Cooking class ... and more various cultural programs



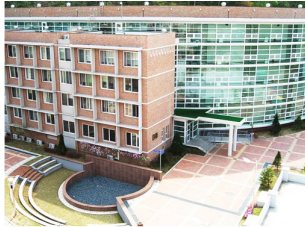

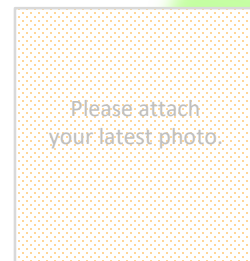
