THESIS ABSTRACT

Conducted based on a relational screening model, this research analyzes the interaction of international students' anxiety levels and future attitudes with socio-demographic variables. The sample consists of 128 foreign students selected through convenience sampling, representing diverse demographic characteristics. Data were collected through face-to-face surveys and analyzed using SPSS software. The study investigates the impact of future attitudes on anxiety levels and whether these two variables differ according to socio-demographic factors. Findings indicate a positive relationship between the students' state and trait anxiety levels and their attitudes toward the future. Additionally, it was found that anxiety levels vary according to certain socio-demographic factors, such as housing type. These results suggest that controlling students' anxiety levels and strengthening positive future perceptions may contribute to their academic and social adaptation processes.

APPLICATION AREAS OF THE THESIS RESULTS

It is thought that the relevant study will be beneficial for the studies to be carried out by universities and educational institutions aiming for internationalization in the field of education regarding international students.
